Action Name: Council Areas of Focus

Action Preamble:

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedar Highlands being a new town, results in an inordinate amount of work to be done in a timely manner by the Cedar Highlands Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, being elected to represent the property owners and residents of Cedar Highlands, Town Council members will endeavor to elicit input from community members along with appropriate interface with government leaders, boards, and commissions.

WHEREAS, Town Council members working on different areas of focus, will allow more to be done concurrently, under the leadership of Town Council members, overseen by the mayor and with input from community members.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town:

Action Body:

The members of the Town Council identified at the Council work meeting of 11/12/2018 that the following areas were of paramount interest for the establishment and efficient operation of the business of the Town:

- Finance (including interaction with the Town Treasurer and signature authority on Town bank account[s], and budget development).
- Roads and Public Works (including interaction with entities such as Iron County Roads Planning Agency meetings, solicitation of funding for road improvement, and snow removal issues for 2019 and beyond).
- Public Safety (including law enforcement, house fire, and emergency medicine)
- Woodland Fire (including interaction with the Bureau of Land Management and Forestry, Fire and State Lands personnel).
- Infrastructure (including interaction with the Iron Country Water Conservancy and Water Board, Rocky Mountain Power, Dominion Energy, and electronic communications entities [e.g., internet and telecom providers]).
- Community Connection (includes open dialogue with Town property owners to facilitate interaction and attention to their concerns, ideas, and suggested avenues for moving forward. Also, a responsibility will be assisting the Web Master in any way that is needed.)

In January of each year, four council members shall select at least one Area of Focus and:

1. Council members will help one another in any and all Areas of Focus.
2. Council members will seek community members' ideas and concerns.
