Action Name: Iron County Sheriff's Department as Law Enforcement for the Town

Action Preamble:

WHEREAS, in the State of Utah law enforcement protection is mandated for all incorporated municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cedar Highlands is a residential community populated by full-time and seasonal part-time residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town council has determined it is in the public interest to ensure that the population and properties within the Town are protected by trained and licensed law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Town council has determined that it is not fiscally prudent to establish their own municipal law enforcement force as of the date of this ordinance, nor is it prudent to utilize part-time private security for law enforcement for an established, incorporated, rural municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the town:

Action Body: The Town Council shall establish the Iron County Sheriff's Department as the official law enforcement entity for the Town until this ordinance is repealed by the Town Council. The Town Council, realizing that insufficient funds were allocated in the 2018-2019 fiscal budget for law enforcement, shall meet in consultation with the appropriate Iron County officials to develop a plan to pay for the remuneration of the 2018 coverage and will work to reconcile the budget to fully cover the expenses for 2019 and beyond until repeal of this ordinance.

Action Penalty: No Penalties are applicable

Action Effective Date: Within ten days or as soon as published on the Cedar Highlands Town Website
